Covid update:

We continue to follow the England Squash roadmap ([England Squash - Guidance for clubs, venues and coaches](#)).

AP: Phil to liaise with YLC head office to discuss logistics of holding club nights ASAP in line with the new regs. Patience needed on this as YLC likely to be, cautious in their approach.

It was discussed and agreed that any return to club activity would mean that all members/players should take every care to follow all rules and regs.

Tournaments:

Hoping to put together 2 tournaments together as COVID allows. Propose that some funds in the kitty subsidise the tournament. With £5 PP. to enter.

It was agreed that we should try and pencil some provisional dates in the diary as soon as possible. Date to be proposed as a provisional date for the Tourney.

AP: Phil to suggest dates as and when govt. Squash England, and YLC processes allows.

Teams:

Phil: Led by COVID rules – Avon league and England Squash need to confirm rules and regs and looking at 21 June onwards at the very earliest for inter-club competition. Avon need to sort out seedings but not really our issue as we are in a lower league.

We were nearly at a point of having 2 teams pre-covid, we hope to be able to be in the same position when we can get back to normal.
